



# DEADLINES for COMPLIANCE

## MARCH 19, 2018

FSVP Importer whose foreign supplier is required to comply with the **PC rule for human food** and considered a **Small Businesses** (as defined in 21 CFR 117.3)

FSVP Importer of animal food whose foreign supplier is subject to **CGMP requirements** and considered a **Small Businesses** (as defined in 21 CFR 507.3)

FSVP Importer whose foreign supplier is required to comply with the **PC rule for animal food** (but that is not required to comply with the **CGMP requirements** in subpart B of 21 CFR part 507.)

## JULY 26, 2018

FSVP importer whose foreign supplier is required to comply with the **PS rule**, (except for the requirements applicable to sprouts, subpart M of 21 CFR part 112).

FSVP importer whose foreign supplier is required to comply with the requirements in the **PS rule** applicable to **sprouts** and considered a **Small Businesses** (as defined in 21 CFR 112.3)

FSVP importer whose foreign supplier is a farm producing sprouts that is eligible for a qualified exemption under the **PS rule** and considered a **Small Businesses** (as defined in 21 CFR 112.3)

## MARCH 18, 2019

FSVP Importer whose foreign supplier is required to comply with the **PC rule for human food** and considered a **Qualified Facility** - including a **Very Small Businesses** (as defined in 21 CFR 117.3)

FSVP Importer whose foreign supplier is required to comply with the **PC rule for animal food** (but that is not required to comply with the **CGMP** of 21 CFR part 507) and is considered a **Small Businesses** (as defined in 21

FSVP Importer whose foreign supplier is required to comply with the **PC rule for human food** and subject to **Pasteurized Milk Ordinance**

FSVP Importer of animal food whose foreign supplier is subject to **CGMP requirements** and considered a **Qualified Facility** - including a **Very Small Businesses** (as defined in 21 CFR 507.3)

## JULY 29, 2019

FSVP importer whose foreign supplier is required to comply with the requirements in the **PS rule** applicable to **sprouts** and considered a **Very Small Businesses** (as defined in 21

FSVP importer whose foreign supplier is required to comply with the **PS rule**, (except for the requirements applicable to sprouts in subpart M, 21 CFR part 112.3) and considered a **Small Businesses** (as defined in 21

FSVP importer whose foreign supplier is a farm producing sprouts that is eligible for a qualified exemption under the **PS rule** and considered a **Very Small Businesses** (as defined in 21 CFR 112.3)

# DEADLINES for COMPLIANCE

MARCH 17, 2020

FSVP Importer whose foreign supplier is required to comply with the **PC rule** for **animal food** (but is **not** required to comply with **CGMP** of 21 CFR part 507) and is considered a **Qualified Facility** including a **Very Small Businesses** (defined in 21 CFR 507.3)

JULY 27, 2020

FSVP importer whose foreign supplier is required to comply with the **PS rule**, (except for the requirements applicable to sprouts, subpart M of 21 CFR part 112) and considered a **Very Small Businesses** (as defined in 21 CFR 112.3)

FSVP importer whose foreign supplier is subject to the **PS rule** and eligible for a **qualified exemption** and considered a to be a **Very Small Businesses** (as defined in 21 CFR 112.3)

## DEFINITIONS

**Small Businesses as defined in 21 CFR 112.3:** a farm that is subject to any of the requirements of this part and, on a rolling basis, the average annual monetary value of produce (as defined in this section) the farm sold during the previous 3-year period is no more than \$500,000; and the farm is not a very small business as defined in this section.

**Very Small Businesses as defined in 21 CFR 112.3:** a farm that is subject to any of the requirements of this part and, on a rolling basis, the average annual monetary value of produce (as defined in this section) the farm sold during the previous 3-year period is no more than \$250,000.

**Small Businesses as defined in 21 CFR 117.3:** a business (including any subsidiaries and affiliates) employing fewer than 500 full-time equivalent employees.

**Small Businesses as defined in 21 CFR 507.3:** a business (including any subsidiaries and affiliates) employing fewer than 500 full-time equivalent employees.

**Qualified Facilities (including Very Small Businesses) as defined in 21 CFR 117.3:** a facility that is a very small business as defined in this part, or a facility to which both of the following apply: (1) During the 3-year period preceding the applicable calendar year, the average annual monetary value of the food manufactured, processed, packed or held at such facility that is sold directly to qualified end-users during such period exceeded the average annual monetary value of the food sold by such facility to all other purchasers; and (2) The average annual monetary value of all food sold during the 3-year period preceding the applicable calendar year was less than \$500,000, adjusted for inflation.

**Very Small Businesses as defined in 21 CFR 117.3:** a business (including any subsidiaries and affiliates) averaging less than \$1,000,000, adjusted for inflation, per year, during the 3-year period preceding the applicable calendar year in sales of human food...

**Very Small Businesses as defined in 21 CFR 507.3:** a business (including any subsidiaries and affiliates) averaging less than \$2,500,000, adjusted for inflation, per year, during the 3-year period preceding the applicable calendar year in sales of animal food...
